Ref: Y11 Parents' Information & Study skills Evening

We will be holding the above information evening on **Thursday 19 October 2017** between 6.00 – 6.30 pm. The purpose of the evening is to give pupils and their parents a clear outline of the information needed to be successful in the first round of Y11 Mock exams which commence on Monday 20th November 2017 and last until Thursday 30th November 2017.

Preparation is the key to success in these mock exams and all Y11 pupils should now be completing home learning each evening and spending at least 45 minutes to 1 hour revising for their mock exams. Over the next two weeks in school, pupils will work on a revision timetable with their Form Tutors that they should try to work to over the half-term week.

Your child should by now be regularly attending after-school intervention sessions put on by their class teachers. Apart from the maths intervention on a Wednesday evening where all pupils must attend, interventions in other subject areas will be at the request of the class teacher or Head of Department.

As a parent, your support is so important in ensuring that your child is able to fulfil their full potential and we are very grateful for your support at this very important time.
