Open Evenings - How to make the most of them.
It is your chance to

- Look around the facilities for students
- Pick up a prospectus and course information
- Find out what courses are available
- Check out entry requirements
- Find out what the courses will be like - content, teaching methods and how the course will be assessed

Before you go

- Look at the college/school website so you have a general idea of what courses they do
- Think about whether there are any specific courses you definitely want to find out about - it may be busy and you want to make the most of your visit

Some questions you could ask

- What does the course involve and how long is it?
- What are the entry requirements for the course? Do I need specific subjects?
- What is the interview like for the course? (for instance is it a group interview, 1:1 interview etc)
- How is the course taught? - is it practical/workshop based, classroom based etc
- How is the course assessed? - exams, assignments, practical assessments
- What do students do after the course? - further study, go into work/training & what sorts
- Transport - if you are going to have to travel to college by bus/train etc, is there a college bus etc

What else you can look at when you are there

Student facilities - including library, cafe, student services, sports facilities
