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| Democracy | Topic covered within: | Knowledge, skills and understanding about becoming informed citizens are acquired and applied across all year groups. Embedding student understanding around the importance of living in a democracy is explored through media texts. In many schemes we consider the importance of the press and analyse a range of newspapers and magazines. |
| The rule of the law | Topic covered within: | Several units cover the range of laws and regulations that govern and monitor the British media. |
| Individual Liberty | Topic covered within: | In studying Media Studies, students will be required to reflect on those concepts which define the nature of the individual, the place of the individual in society and relations between individuals. In acquiring some understanding of these matters, students will develop as more sensitive, more caring and more sophisticated citizens. Most of schemes of learning involve at least some element of discussion pertaining to individual choice. |



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| Mutual Respect | Topic covered within: | We read a range of media texts that consider the representation of different cultures. These texts explore the presentation of positive media image and stereotyping and addresses how this can have both positive and negative connotations for these individuals and groups. |
| Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs | Topic covered within: | Throughout the study of Media Studies, students explore the human condition and evaluate their own existence and values in relation to society. In developing their skills students address a wide range of human issues. |
