

### LAC report 2016/17

We currently have 5 LAC pupils in the school. 3 in Y7, 1 in Y8 and 1 in Y10. We also have 4 Y6 LAC children who are joining St Patrick's in September 2017. The children come from two local authorities, namely, Stockton and Middlesbrough.

As the designated lead for LAC, I have attended 3 PEP meetings for each of the 5 children currently on roll during the academic year and two LAC review meetings. There has also been care planning meetings for some of the children where a need has arisen. For the boy in Y8 there has also been managed move meetings as he is currently on a MM to Conyers and earlier in the year there were meetings with the Virtual school and All Saints as a MM was attempted there but was unsuccessful. This young man has also spent time in the Bishopton Centre where he has been seen by MB in his placement. MB has also in the last term been attending PEP and LAC review meetings for the Y6 pupils who will be starting with us in September so a smooth transition can be had. Extra transition was also organised for these pupils where necessary before the official transition week.

The LA have QA the PEP documents and there have been no issues raised with the quality. In September Stockton LA will be using an E-PEP which MBO has attended the relevant training for. MBO has also been training Joanne Hawthorne (SENCO) up to cover MBO's LAC duties whilst she is on maternity leave in 2017/18. Joanne has also attended LA training as well as shadowing MBO in meetings in school. The first PEP of the year 2017/18 for each pupil will be held in September by MBO before she goes off on maternity leave. These dates are already scheduled. MBO has attended all the LAC designated teacher meetings as organised by the LA. JHA has the dates for these next year and will attend on behalf of the school.

Attendance of our LAC pupils remains a strength and the average attendance of these pupils is currently 97.98%. (Y7 – 99.45%, Y8 – 84.21%, Y10 – 98.35%) Please note that the attendance of the Y8 pupil only goes up to the 07/11/16 as he has been dual-registered since then. His attendance therefore would be much higher as it has considerably improved since this point.
